## **ODSC Board Meeting Minutes**

## August 5, 2025

The meeting was called to order by President Monica Powell at 6:00 p.m. Eight board members were present and 11 members were in attendance. Monica welcomed everyone.

A motion was made by Sue Wehner and seconded by Monica Powell to approve the July Board Meeting Minutes. Motion was unanimously passed.

Beth Cornwell presented the treasurer's report for the period ending July 31, 2025.

Rick Kosko made the motion to approve the treasurer's report and it was seconded by Sue Wehner. Motion was unanimously passed.

## **Committee Reports**

- Advertising: Carl Sivertsen reported he is working on renewals. Due to Golf Tournament sponsors being sought, the Advertising Committee is not pursuing new advertisers at this time. Carl requested ideas for a means of showing the ODSC sponsors our appreciation. A request was made for the members of the ODSC to support the ODSC sponsors by patronizing their businesses.
- **Dance Lessons:** Monica Powell reported on behalf of Darrell Gaither and Lori Setzer. Shag classes are continuing throughout August for the members.
- Christmas Families: No report
- **Communications:** Susan Hazzard sent in the July report. There were 7736 total recipients of ODSC emails with 7728 successful deliveries and 9983 were opened.
- Entertainment/Decorating: The DJ for the August party will be Jimmy Buffkin.
- **Food:** The August Party menu will include Fried Fish, French Fries, Slaw and Hush Puppies. Rick made a motion that \$1,100 be approved to provide food and other expenses. Sue Wehner made a motion to approve which was seconded by Don May. The motion was unanimously passed.

- **Fun Run:** The Fun Run was a huge success which raised \$2,000 and was awarded to The John Causey Foundation and First Responders. Raffle prizes were given to 68 lucky recipients. The 50/50 winner took home \$615 and Mike Richbourg was the grand winner for the day's event.
- **Golf Cart Fund Raiser**: The Golf Cart Committee reported that as of August 5, \$9,925 has been collected in raffle ticket sales.

 Golf Tournament: Ken Meyer reported plans are going well. Nine more foursomes are participating.

Volunteers are needed to work the tournament. Members are encouraged to volunteer. The committee is securing food prices for the sandwiches that are provided for lunch for the participants. The committee is also wanting to recognize the \$500 sponsors in some way, suggestions are welcomed.

\$4,800 in sponsorship money has been collected thus far.
